

Dear Customer,

The Russian invasion of Ukraine has resulted in several sanctions by the European Union:

- COUNCIL REGULATION (EU) 2023/1214 amending Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of Russia's actions destabilising the situation in Ukraine
- COUNCIL REGULATION (EU) 2022/398 amending Regulation (EC) No 765/2006 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Belarus and the involvement of Belarus in the Russian aggression against Ukraine

With these regulations EU has tightened the restrictions on imports of iron, steel and other goods by requiring importers to prove that the material does not origin from Russia.

We want to assure you that BE Group is fully committed to comply with the current and future sanctions issued by the EU and any other applicable sanctions of other countries, and we expect the same commitment from our customers and our suppliers.
